The Emergence of GACA:

The beginning of Civil Aviation in the Kingdom goes back to the year 1364 AH, when the Kingdom gained its first civil aircraft during the reign of King Abdulaziz. The Kingdom's first civil aviation system was established in 1372AH. The Civil Aviation comprised of Saudi Arabian Airlines and Meteorology Department when it was separated from the Saudi Royal Air Force. The Saudi Arabian Airlines was detached from the Civil Aviation in 1379AH and was followed by Meteorological Department separating in 1386 AH. thus leaving it independent with its own budget. In 1397AH, The Department of Civil Aviation was renamed as the Presidency of Civil Aviation. In 1425AH, The Council of Ministers decided and issued a ruling to transform the Presidency of Civil Aviation to an autonomous entity and named General Authority of Civil Aviation (GACA).

In 1432AH, it has been separated from Ministry of Defense through Royal Decree with redrawn basic organizational structure to let it enjoy a legal and public status with its own administrational and financial independence. The direct supervision of the Premier would give it more motivation and greater independence for smooth and harmonious progress and development of air transport industry.



Preview of Air Traffic at the Kingdom's Airports during 2013:


Following are some significant features of air traffic at Kingdom's airports during the year 2013:

- The number of passengers at Saudi Arabian airports reached more than 68 million passengers, an increase of 5.2 % over 2012.
- The aircraft operations at Kingdom's Airports have increased by 1.2 % over 2012 and reached 565,631 operations and that was due to:
 - ✓ The Introduction of new carriers at Kingdom's airports.
 - ✓ Launching of International flights from some Domestic Airports.
- The volume of Cargo and Mail was 1,059,068 tons, $4\,\%$ more than the volume in 2012 .
- Umrah traffic decreased due to Haram Expansion Project at Makkah in 2013.














Cargo at KFIA increased by 17.6%






Market Share for International & Domestic Airports

- The international Passengers at King Abdulaziz Airport, Jeddah decreased by 2.0% and domestic passengers by 1.8% resulting in 2.0% decrease in total passengers traffic.
- A growth of 9% is noted in Passengers movement at King Khaled International Airport Riyadh, which is due to 11.1% increase in International and 6.9% increase in Domestic Passengers.
- The Passengers movement at King Fahd International Airport, Dammam is 13.9% more than the previous year. The International Passengers grew by 16.1% while Domestic Passengers by 11.5%
- Prince Muhammad Bin Abdulaziz International Airport registered an increase of 7.4% in Passengers movement. The number of International Passengers grew by 10%, and Domestic Passengers by 2.2%.

- Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta has retained its crown as the busiest airport in the world in 2013 but the most notable mover in the top 10 was Dubai International up to 7th place from 10th.
- In sixth spot and growing fast was Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) with 66.6 million passengers, a growth of 4.7% on 2012, just in front of Dubai International in seventh, which saw a 15.2% rise on 2012 to 66.4 million.
- In eighth place, up from ninth, and Asia-Pacific's fourth busiest is Jakarta Soekarno-Hatta, with 62.04 million, up 3.4% on 2012, and narrowly edging out in ninth and Europe's second busiest in 2013, Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport, with 62 million, up 0.7% on 2012.
- Just outside the top 10, was Hong Kong International Airport, which set a new record of 59.9 million travellers, up 6.1% on 2012 and is set to reach the top 10 in 2014.
- Amsterdam Schiphol, handled 52.5 million passengers, a new record, making its Europe's fourth busiest airport.
