

## CERTIFICATION OF THE BATTERY REPLACEMENT OF THE ELT

GACAR Part 91, Appendix C, Section V:				
(d)(1)	Batteries used in the emergency locator transmitter (ELT) must be replaced when the transmitter has been in use for more than 1 cumulative hour			
(d)(2)	Batteries used in the emergency locator transmitter must be replaced when 50% of their useful life has expired, as established by the transmitter manufacturer under its approval.			
(d)(3)	The new expiration date for replacing (or recharging) the battery must be legibly marked on the outside of the transmitter and entered in the aircraft maintenance record. Paragraph (d)(2) of this section does not apply to batteries (such as water activated batteries) that are essentially unaffected during probable storage intervals
