



Regulatory Interim Policy

To : GACA Certified Ground/Flight Instructors
Subject : GACAR Part-61 Certified Ground/Flight Instructors

After a careful review of the current GACA regulations (GACAR Part-61) dealing with the regulatory requirements related to receiving and logging flight/ground training by GACA Certified Ground/Flight Instructors, It is noticed that the current regulations mandate that those Ground/Flight Instructors must be employed by a GACA Certificated Pilot School while logging any ground/flight training.

This mandate of being employed by a GACA Certificated Pilot School for a GACA Certified Ground/Flight Instructors for logging official training is found to be inappropriate and is not in the best interest of the aviation industry within the Kingdom.

Thus, the Aviation Standards Sector is hereby directed to amend the current Aviation Safety Regulations to remove any mandate for the current employment of GACA Certified Ground/Flight Instructors at a GACA Certificated Pilot School, as a condition for being illegible to log any ground/flight training.

The above directive will have an immediate effect until the pertinent Aviation Safety Regulations are amended accordingly.
